CALL FOR COMMENTS AND INVITATION FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION ON THE ADVOCATES COMPLAINTS COMMISSION DRAFT BILL, 2022

The Advocates Complaints Commission (ACC) is in the process of restructuring with the intent to de-link from the Office of the Attorney General and Department of Justice (OAG & DOJ).

The decision to restructure and de-link the ACC from the OAG & DOJ was informed by the recommendation of the OAG Diagnostic Review Report of 2013 that Semi-Autonomous Government Agencies (SAGAs) should be established for departments, such as the ACC, that are executing statutory functions under the supervision of the OAG & DOJ pursuant to section 5 of the OAG Act, No. 49 of 2012.

To effect the recommendation and support the Government's efforts to build effective, accountable, and inclusive institutions, the OAG & DOJ has developed the ACC Draft Bill, 2022.

The ACC Draft Bill, 2022 is available at the websites of OAG&DOJ (www.statelaw.go.ke) and ACC (www.acc.go.ke). Members of the public are requested to submit any representations that they may have on the ACC draft bill, 2022.
